INTERPRETATION: The tables below provide a summary of our research on the outlook for various asset classes based on Short and Long Term time frames. The RelValue indicator gives an indication of how much "Relative Value" can be achieved by investing in this asset when compared to all other available assets. General Comments apply to each asset class.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS: This week saw further improvements in most investment categories. Stockmarkets showed further signs of improving conditions as investors were willing to take on more risk. Bonds at the higher risk end also improved. The Pound showed some short term weakness, notably against the Euro though longer term the outlook remains positive. Commodities improved this week.
